COACHING SOCIETY REPORT 2018

We are still aiming to have a 'Coach in every Club'. We have a large number of Assistant Club Coaches who are working hard to introduce new bowlers to our game. What we would like to see is a Club Coach in every club now. In 2018, 9 Assistant Club Coaches qualified as Club Coaches, for a total of 4 different clubs. These coaches can now offer their services to other clubs in other areas and I know that some already have done so.

We also have four new Assistant Club Coaches and I know that there are others awaiting a seminar. If you have anyone in your club who would like to attend an Assistant Club Coach seminar please let me know. This is the 'first rung' on the coaching ladder and teaches you how to teach beginners and also includes etiquette, safeguarding, scoring and rules of the game.

Attendance at an Assistant Club Coach seminar is £25

Attendance at a Club Coach seminar and subsequent assessment is a further £125

A Community Chest grant should cover all coaching fees and bowls equipment.
