

BCGBA REPORT 2020

Rules Passed at the BCGBA AGM

1. Officers of the Association can now vote at general meetings.
2. Dress code rule now reads - 'Suitable footwear must be worn. Hard, block-healed or open-toed footwear must not be worn on the green in any match under the Association's jurisdiction.'
The word 'sandal' has been removed from this rule, as not all sandals are open-toed.
3. The Supplementary has reverted back to including the Isle of Man in the competition. This means that the bottom team in the three team section will be replaced by the IOM.
4. Clarification has now been made on the final games in the Supplementary. In the Final, four games will be played on two greens. The second four games of the Final will not start until the first four games have been completed. If both teams involved in the Final agree, the Final can be played on one green. If a venue has a third suitable, unused green, the Final can be played on this green.
5. The criteria for the Champion of Champions qualification will now be published in the BCGBA hand book.
6. The Centenary Mixed Pairs will revert to a two green venue decided by the BCGBA Management.

General information.

Wales have four qualifiers for this years British Senior Merit competition.

The formula of the British Junior Championship for Wales has not changed for the 2020 season ie with five teams in the Premier Division.
